September, 2011. Ever wonder what happened to each of the survivors onboard the *Titanic*? For the first time in the world, the Titanic Museum Attraction in Branson, Mo will guide you through the individual journeys of each of the survivors on our NEW EXCLUSIVE Survivors' Wall of Stories.

“So many guests ask us, “What happened to our passenger that survived on our boarding pass?” For the first time in the world, after two years of research, we have been able to put their lives together after they reached New York City almost 100 years ago”, co-owner Mary Kellogg-Joslyn explains.



Titanic Museum Attraction organized a team of historians from around the world and after two years of research, compiled these survivors' stories. Until now, the number of survivors has been unknown due to the inconsistent records kept by the rescue ship, Carpathia. Their list of rescues included duplicates and missing survivor names. Now, Titanic Museum Attraction has released one of the most detailed pieces of *Titanic* information ever compiled. There were 712 passengers and crew who were rescued including 201 from First Class, 118 from Second Class, 181 from Third Class, and 212 Crew Members.
