WHERE WERE YOU 20 YEARS AGO?

“Where were you 20 years ago when TITANIC was released? I remember it clearly...my wife, Mary, and I were in a Hollywood theater watching the fictionalized version of the RMS *Titanic* story unfold. We were mesmerized by the fantastic images and Oscar-worthy performances. Unlike anybody else, though, it reminded me of my own non-fiction encounters with this ship.”

Thirty years ago – one year after *Titanic*'s discovery in 1985 – my team and I were two miles below the surface of the North Atlantic, probing the darkness for the ghostly remains of the very real RMS *Titanic*. Suddenly, there she was, shrouded in rusticles, still stately and proud, ready for the close-up my partner, Doug Llewelyn, and I had come to shoot for our television company's production, **RETURN TO TITANIC...LIVE** – the first *Titanic* television special to be seen by viewers around the world. We spent 44 days at sea, conducted 32 dives to the wreck site, recovered long lost *Titanic* treasures, and went on to produce the most watched television special ever made.

“Now, for the first time, *Titanic*'s real life and reel life will come together in one place – a place built on a dream I had 30 years ago, 12,460 feet beneath the sea. I hope you'll join me in celebrating TITANIC's twentieth anniversary, here at the **Titanic Museum Attraction in Branson**...where the legacy of the Ship of Dreams lives on,” Joslyn says.
